As defined as a Scotch made from malted barley from a single distillery. With the many styles resulting from unique climates in the different areas of Scotland, we are proud to showcase the four main areas of Single Malt production.

THE HIGHLANDS

Typically the most popular area for Scotch production with appealing flavors and an easy drinking style.



1 McCLELLANDS HIGHLAND \$6

Specially chosen to highlight this area's unique flavors in scotch making. Produced at the Glen Garioch distillery. Malt with a dry peatd nose and hints of cinnamon and hazelnut.

2 THE GLENLIVET 12YR HIGHLAND \$8

One of the most famous malts in the world. Glenlivet 12yo has a soft smooth balance of sweet summer fruits and the floral notes of spring flowers. Aged in both American and European Oak

SPEYSIDE

Racy malts that feature a little grainy sweetness and slight smoke.



3 McCLELLANDS SPEYSIDE \$6

Speyside, Scotland- Scents of butterscotch and malted barley, common in Speyside single malts, greet you. Texture is creamy and goes nicely with the sweetness of this zesty drink.

4 GLENGRANT 12YR SPEYSIDE \$9

Bright gold with aromas of honey, pear, and apple with hints of almond and citrus. The palate highlights notes of apple pie crust, caramel, and vanilla. Finishes with lingering fruit and subtle hints of spice.

ISLAY

Coastal island distilleries that feature smoky, and sea-air character.



5 McCLELLANDS ISLAY \$6

Distilleries on the island are famous throughout the world for their peaty characteristic and dry finish; Behind the smoke, however, are gentle mossy scents, traces of seaweed and just a hint of spice.

6 ARDBEG "WEEBEASTIE" ISLAY \$8⁵⁰

This 5 year old single malt is matured in ex Bourbon and Oloroso Sherry casks. Features a bright, fresh, herbal nose followed by a rich, explosive mouthfeel.

LOWLANDS

a drier area of production that needs less smoke in their malts.



7 McCLELLANDS LOWLAND \$6

Specially chosen to highlight this area's unique flavors in scotch making. Produced in the Lowlands this is fruity and flowery with oak and caramel with a clean taste and no peat.

8 AUCHENTOSHEN AMERICAN OAK \$8

Aroma of cinnamon, pine needles fresh cut oak, toasted almonds, and orange rinds. Taste peppery, caramel, spiced apple cider, maple syrup, and nutmeg. With all the taste combined it gives a nice smooth finish.
