



Tee - Time Reservation Policy

Tee times may be reserved by calling 254-1745 or in person at the Golf Pro Shop on the days and times indicated below by patron priority:

 Active Duty and Dependents aboard or supported by Marine Corps Base Hawaii

> Marine Corps Active Duty and Dependents (including members assigned to the installation from reserve components when on active duty for training in excess of 72 hours)

9 days prior starting at 1200

 All Other Active Duty and Dependents (including members of reserve components when on active duty for training in excess of 72 hours) 7 days prior starting at 1200

3. Retired Marines and Dependents

7 days prior starting at 1300

4. All Other Retired Military and and Dependents

6 days prior starting at 0800

All Other Reserve, DoD & Other Authorized Patrons 6 days prior starting at 1200

Patrons that do not reserve tee times in advance have the option to utilize the **STAND-BY LIST**. The policy for all stand-by play gives priority to the active-duty members and dependents assigned to and supported by Marine Corps Base Hawaii. No "Bumping" is allowed; this policy does not allow priority over those who have already reserved a tee time.

Group Play

Advance bookings are taken for groups seeking three (3) tee times or more. Groups may submit their requests up to one (1) year in advance. Groups must have at least one (1) Authorized Patron to book the reservation. Group play will not be booked before 0930 on weekends and holidays. Five-somes are allowed Monday-Friday, and Four-somes only during weekends and holidays.

Tournament Play

The rules and procedures for Group Play apply for advance bookings for Tournament Play. Tournaments that book 18-hole shotguns and provide a minimum of 144 players (maximum of 160 players) will have exclusivity to the golf course. This means the 18-hole golf course will be closed to regular patrons until the completion of the tournament. All other tournaments will be modified to allow regular patrons (NO EXCLUSIVITY) to fill unused capacity during tournament operations.
