

2024 KLIPPER AMATEUR Golf Tournament

- ENTRY FEE:** \$205.00 – Includes green fees for up to three tournament rounds and one practice round (Monday thru Wednesday). Cart fees are not included.
- FORMAT:** 54 Hole Stroke Play
- ELIGIBILITY:** Amateur Golfers with GHIN Handicap (Field Limited to 120 Golfers)
- TOURNAMENT:** The Tournament Champion will be the player with the lowest 54 hole score regardless of flight assignment. In the event of a tie, a sudden death play-off will decide the winner of each flight. There will also be an “Active Duty” Champion. This award will go to the Active Duty player with the lowest “Net” score after 36 holes. In the event of a tie, a scorecard play-off will decide the winner.
- FLIGHTS:**
Championship Flight (0.0 to 4.9 handicap index)
A Flight (5.0-9.9 handicap index)
B Flight (10.0 or higher handicap index)
Senior Flight (must be 55 yrs old before 1st day of competition)
*Tee times and flight assignments will be available one week prior on October 17 at 12:00 pm
- FIELD CUT:** Field will be cut by approximately 50% after 36 holes
- PRACTICE ROUNDS:** Available Oct 21 – Oct 23, Call the Klipper Pro Shop at 808-254-1745 up to 6 days prior for tee times
- LUNCH:** Lunch will be provided on Thursday and Friday
- ENTRY RULES:** Entries must be received by C.O.B. Monday, October 7. Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. Players will be notified of acceptance via email. All entries are subject to approval by the tournament committee. Contestants may be assigned to different flights if scores reflect inaccurate handicaps before or during the tournament.
- DRESS CODE:** Collared Shirts and Spikeless Golf Shoes are required. Swimwear, gym attire, and cutoffs not allowed.
- PRIZES:** Gift Certificates, Prize pool will be determined by the number of entries per flight
- AWARDS CEREMONY:** Awards Ceremony after final round
- GUESTS GATE PASSES:** Civilian participants (players only) will be issued a Special Events Pass for the duration of the golf tournament, to include practice rounds. However, it is encouraged that players and their guests apply for a Public Partners Program (PPP) pass. As a PPP member, you will have base access for one year and authorized to utilize the Golf Course and Bowling Alley. PPP members are issued a vehicle sticker, ID card and do not have to check-in at the Pass House for daily visits. Follow the link below to our PPP page and apply online.
