MCB HAWAII MILITARY ACADEMIC SKILLS PROGRAM (MASP)

WHAT IS MASP? A four-week, daytime, in-the-classroom course that delivers 120 hours of writing, reading comprehension, and math curriculum. Material ranges from 8th grade through 12th grade.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND MASP? Marines with an ASVAB General Technical (GT) score of **99** or below have *priority enrollment*. A GT score of **100-119** will be placed on standby. MASP is not appropriate for those with GT scores of **120 or above** – those Marines are encouraged to use Tuition Assistance and take CLEP & DSST exams for academic credit. The free Online Academic Skills Course (OASC) – the online version of MASP – is also available. Please see the Education Center for more information on OASC.

WHEN IS MASP? Monday – Friday, 0800 – 1500 (with 1-hour lunch). See 2025 MASP Calendar on back.

WHERE IS MASP? MASP is conducted in the MCB Hawaii – Kaneohe Bay Education Center (Bldg. 220).

WHY DO MASP? Marines and Sailors take MASP for many different reasons, including work performance improvement, advancement, qualification for lateral MOS moves, application to specialized schools, officer candidacy, preparation for college-level courses, and/or as an academic “refresher.”

OTHER IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT MASP:

- \$40 cash enrollment fee paid to the Hawaii State Department of Education’s (DOE) Waipahu School for Adults – Windward Campus, to cover course materials. MASP is a partnership with Hawaii DOE.
- 100% attendance (barring emergencies) is essential due to MASP’s intense, accelerated curriculum.
- Due to the academic demands of MASP, we respectfully ask that units not place participants on overnight duty from Sunday through Thursday.
- 100% accountability of the Marine or Sailor is paramount and taken very seriously by our team.
- Family members and on-base civilians may attend on a space-available basis. (Must be 18 or have an approved release from compulsory attendance Form 4140).
