

MCCCS HITT: UPCOMING HERO WODS

"WAR FRANK" HERO WOD~ SAT, MAR 29

In Memory of Capt Warren Frank

KIA 25 Nov 2008, Near Baiji, Iraq, in the Ninevah province

While a member of 5th Air Naval Gunfire Liaison Company (5th Anglico) "WarFrank" was on his 3rd deployment to Iraq as the OIC of Fire Control Team 4, 1st Brigade Platoon, 5th Anglico. He was killed while distributing humanitarian aid when he came under small-arms fire from an attacker dressed in an Iraqi soldiers uniform.

Lt. Consaul- "I did two combat deployments with Frank in 2005 and 2007 while he was an infantry platoon commander with V3/1 and I was a tank platoon commander. He had seen his share of combat and no one would have batted an eye if

he had taken an "easy" B billet and gone to the schoolhouse or some other HQ billet. But he was dedicated to the service and asked to go to 5th Anglico, knowing full well it meant another deployment pretty quick. He was an outstanding Marine Officer, well respected by his marines and peers alike. He was caring, funny, helpful, competent, humble, a good friend, loving husband and father, and all around a great Marine.I miss him. He would have been a shoo-in for a Battalion Commander at this point."

Scale by reducing reps/assisted pushups.






