FUTENMA FLIGHT LINE FAIR Flightline Fair Do's and Don'ts

Do's:

- 1. Identification: Ensure you have a valid photo ID, such as a driver's license or passport required for entry.
- 2. **Comfortable Clothing:** Dress appropriately for the weather and event. Consider wearing comfortable shoes for walking and no offensive or inappropriate clothing.
- 3. Cash and Cards: Bring some cash and credit/debit cards for food, merchandise, and other purchases as not all vendors may accept cards.
- 4. **Reusable Water Bottle:** Bring a reusable water bottle that you can refill throughout the day. There will be water stations provided while you wait for entry.
- 5. **Sun Protection:** It's an outdoor fair. Bring sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat to protect yourself from the sun.
- 6. Backpack or Tote Bag: <u>All bags are subject to search.</u> A clear bag is recommended to facilitate entry through security checks.
- 7. Child Care Essentials: Pack diapers, changing supplies, baby food, snacks, feeding supplies, spare clothing, blankets, safety gear, entertainment, a baby carrier or stroller, and any necessary baby monitors or ID bracelets for your child's safety and comfort during the fair.
- 8. **Respect Restrictions:** Respect any posted signs, instructions, and all barriers regarding photography. There will be restrictions on how close and what angles certain aircraft or military equipment may be photographed from. Follow any additional photography policies or guidelines provided by the fair organizers, static display participants, or military installation authorities.
- 9. **Privacy and Consent:** Always ask for permission before taking photos of individuals, especially military personnel, or their families.

Don'ts:

- 1. Prohibited Items:
 - a. Weapons or firearms of any kind.
 - b. Illegal Substances and outside Alcohol.
 - c. Pets are not allowed.
 - d. Drones.
- 2. Unauthorized Recording: Unauthorized recording is prohibited. Please keep photos of aircraft and the event generic. Do not attempt to take photos of restricted or sensitive areas, military personnel, or any activities that could compromise security. All photos and videos are subject to review and may be deleted.
- 3. Littering: Dispose of trash responsibly and use designated bins for waste.
- 4. **Disruptive Behavior:** Be respectful of military personnel and other attendees. Avoid any disruptive or disrespectful behavior.
