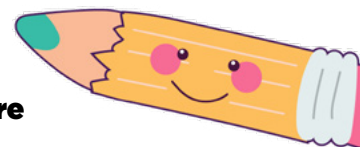

This event is not affiliated with the national Drive, Chip & Putt program and is a competitive event, not an instructional clinic.

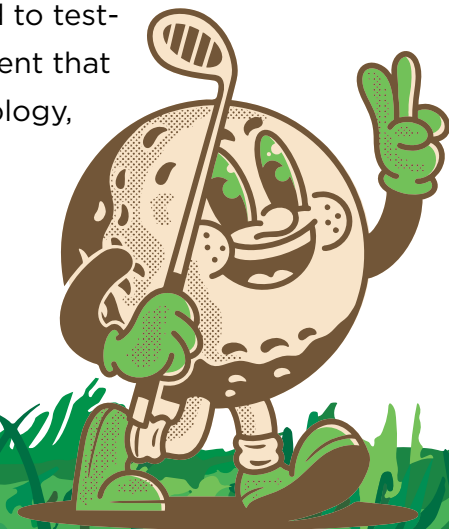

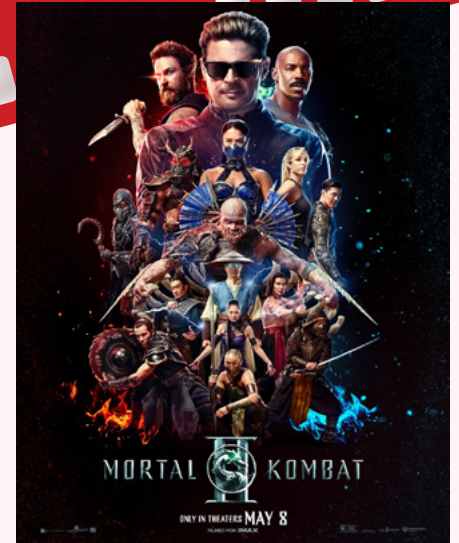

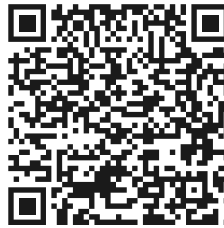
