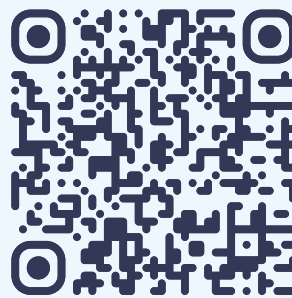

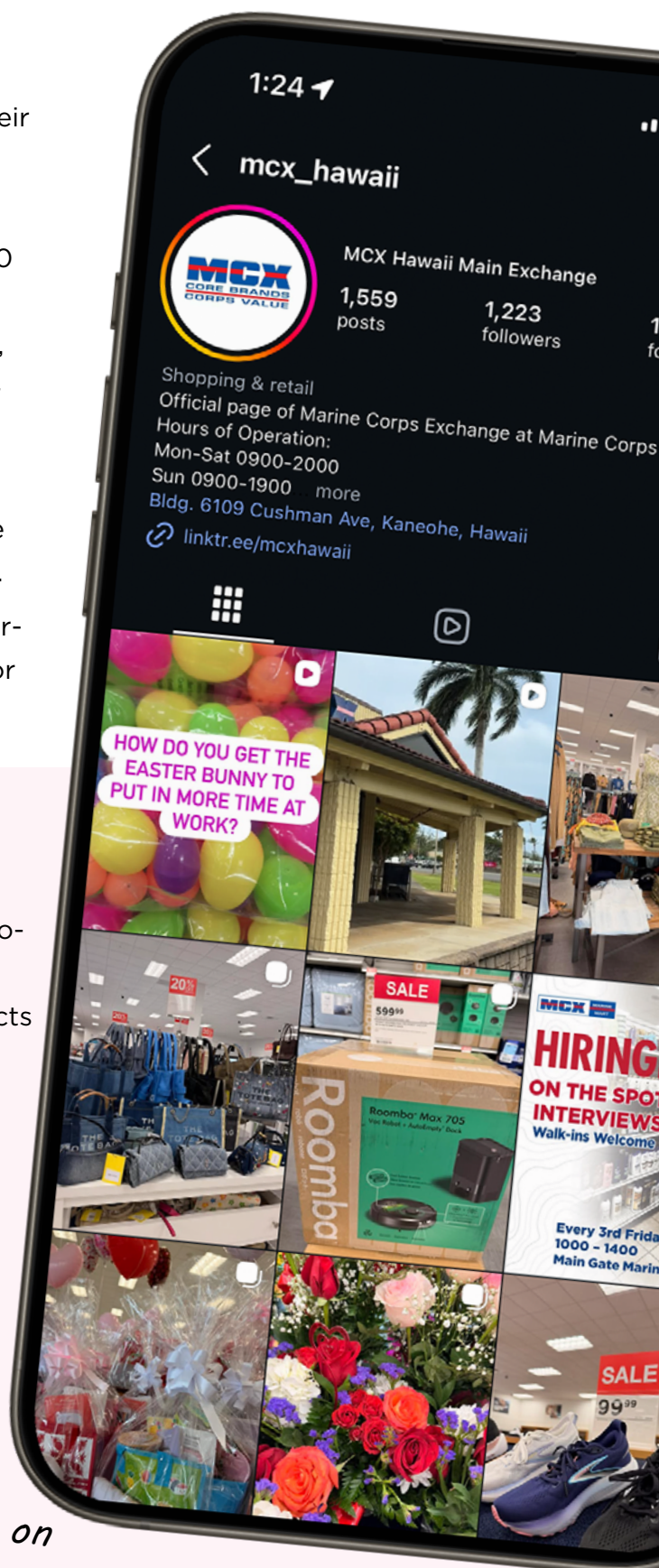

DONAHUE

AUGUST HERO WOD

AUGUST 26, 1200, SgtMaj Porter Field

Cpl. Max Donahue was born on July 14, 1987, in Highlands Ranch, Colorado, enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps in 2006, and after completing boot camp, MOS training, and K-9 school, was assigned to Marine Corps Base Hawaii before deploying to Iraq in 2008 as a Military Working Dog (MWD) handler and earning a meritorious promotion to corporal. In 2010, he transferred to I Marine Expeditionary Force at Camp Pendleton and deployed to Helmand Province, Afghanistan, with his MWD, Fenji, where he located an improvised explosive device before a secondary IED detonated during a firefight, leaving him critically injured. Cpl. Donahue died from his wounds on August 7, 2010, at the age of 23, while Fenji survived the blast, returned to duty, and was later retired and adopt-

ed. Remembered for his courage and selflessness, Cpl. Donahue was posthumously awarded the Purple Heart and Combat Action Ribbon, earned numerous other military decorations, and is buried at Cedar Hill Cemetery in Castle Rock, Colorado.

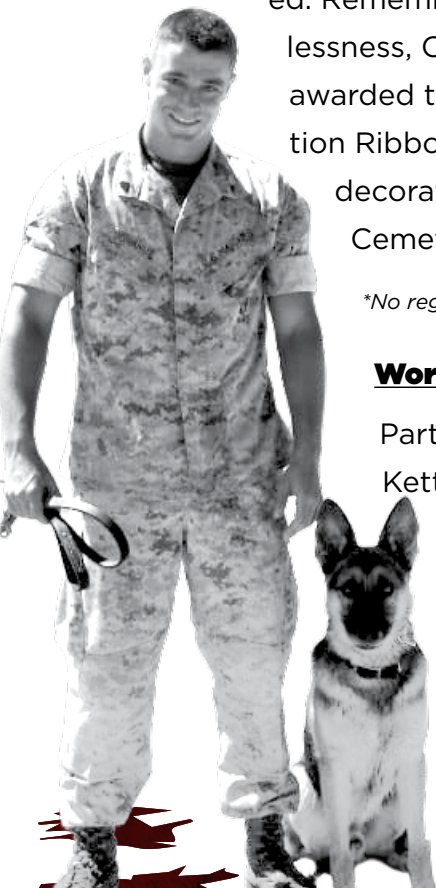
